Trails Are Still Closed

Barclay Trail is CLOSED due to logging

Barclay Trail is closed due to logging. Please stay off this trail until it is announced that it is back open. If you are caught on the trail during closure, you will get a ticket. The Sherriff Patrol will be keeping an eye on this trail.

Tailwater Lodge will be selling memberships and maps this year. If you stay there and want to ride the trails, you need to buy a membership and a map. It is not included in your stay.

VIP Stickers: new for this year, if you see a machine with one of these stickers, it could be a landowner, board member, Sherriff Patrol, trail patrol or trail bosses.

Newsletters will only be posted on Facebook and the website, this is due to recent price increases for printing and postage, also time constraints from working a full-time job in the medical field. Sorry for any inconvenience.

Brian Clark and Jeff Paquette are overseeing the maps. There will be some updating done and will be available for June. The trails will be in different colors, businesses and sponsors will be numbered. Thank you both for taking on this task.

The weight limit for machines is now 2,000lbs, no leeway.

Memberships:

Single: \$35, 1 machine only

<u>Family</u>: \$45, up to 3 machines only, \$10 for each additional machine, maximum of 5 machines for family membership

Each application **WILL** require machine year, brand, model, color, UTV dry weight total, plate number (if legally registerable in NYS). ANY application **NOT** containing all information, will not be processed.

All machines allowed on the trail system **MUST** have the yearly membership sticker placed on the front left of the machine, so it is visible.

Riding on a membership receipt will no longer be allowed.

Replacement stickers will be **\$10**

1-day passes are ONLY for the month of September, \$15

Memberships are mailed after payment methods have been cleared, whether it's a check, money order, PayPal, etc. All applications are reviewed for completeness, accuracy of information for machines, that rules are signed in agreement, addresses, phone numbers, etc. If something is not complete, this will delay

the mailing of your membership card and stickers. This applies to online memberships as well, these are also printed and reviewed.

After May 1st, memberships will be available by appointment during the week and at the campground on the weekends
